Public Safety Canada calls for Submissions on New National Cybersecurity Strategy

On August 16, 2016, Public Safety Canada ("PSC") issued a <u>consultation</u> <u>paper</u>, launching a public consultation as part of PSC's development of an updated national cybersecurity strategy (the "Consultation Paper"). The consultation will close on October 15, 2016. Business may want to consider making submissions in respect of some key questions posed around possible regulation or standard-setting regarding Internet of Things and connected devices, certification for E-commerce activities, and information sharing (especially in respect of critical infrastructure).
